



Cisco VPN Remote Access Setup

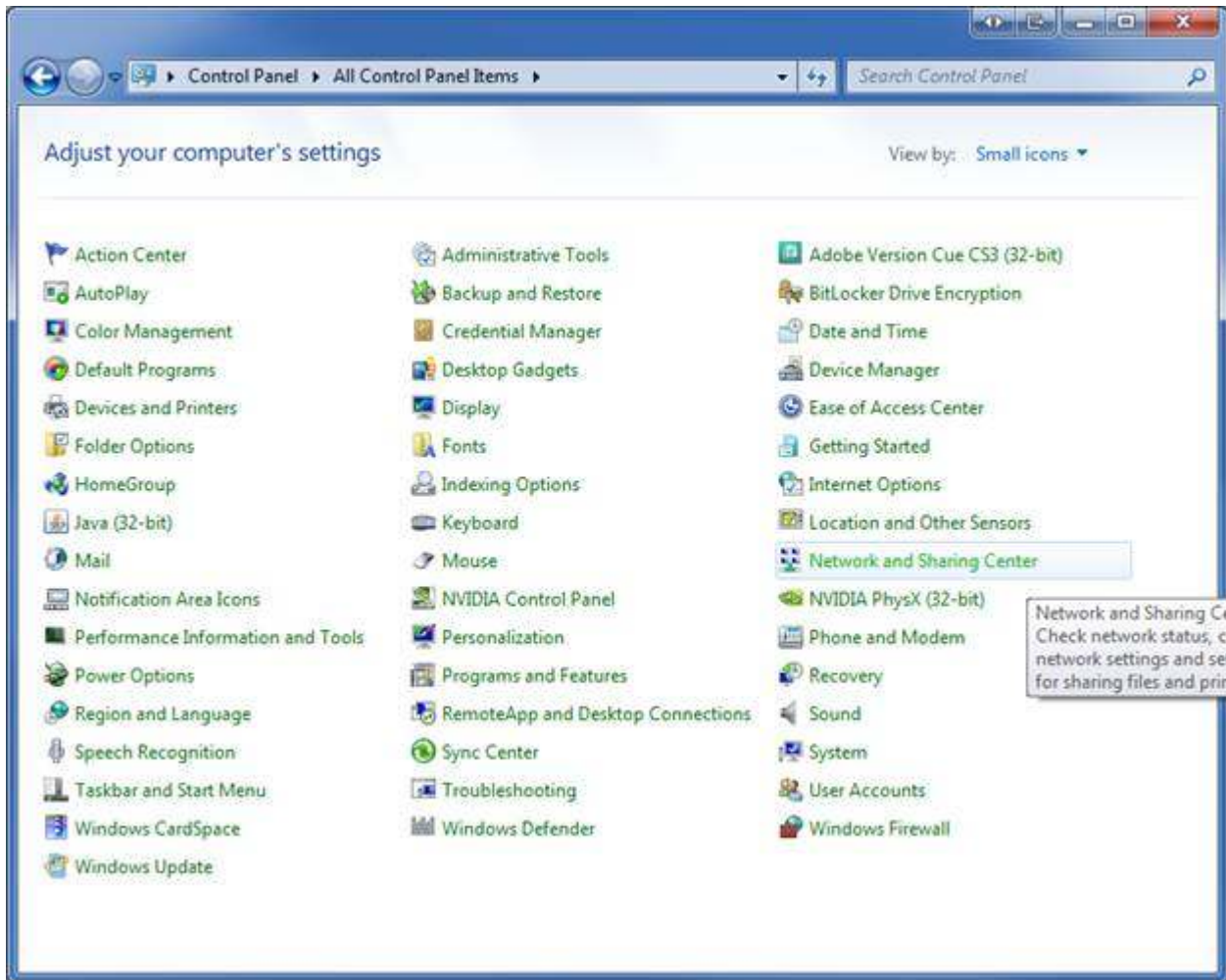
This document was created for clients that wish to connect to their work computers and will apply to clients who have deployed the Cisco VPN technology. If your organization uses Fortigate Web-VPN technology, please refer to that document.

Before you begin, you will need the name of your work PC. On your work PC, go to Start > right click Computer > Properties > Computer Name. In this case, we are using TOMWIN7

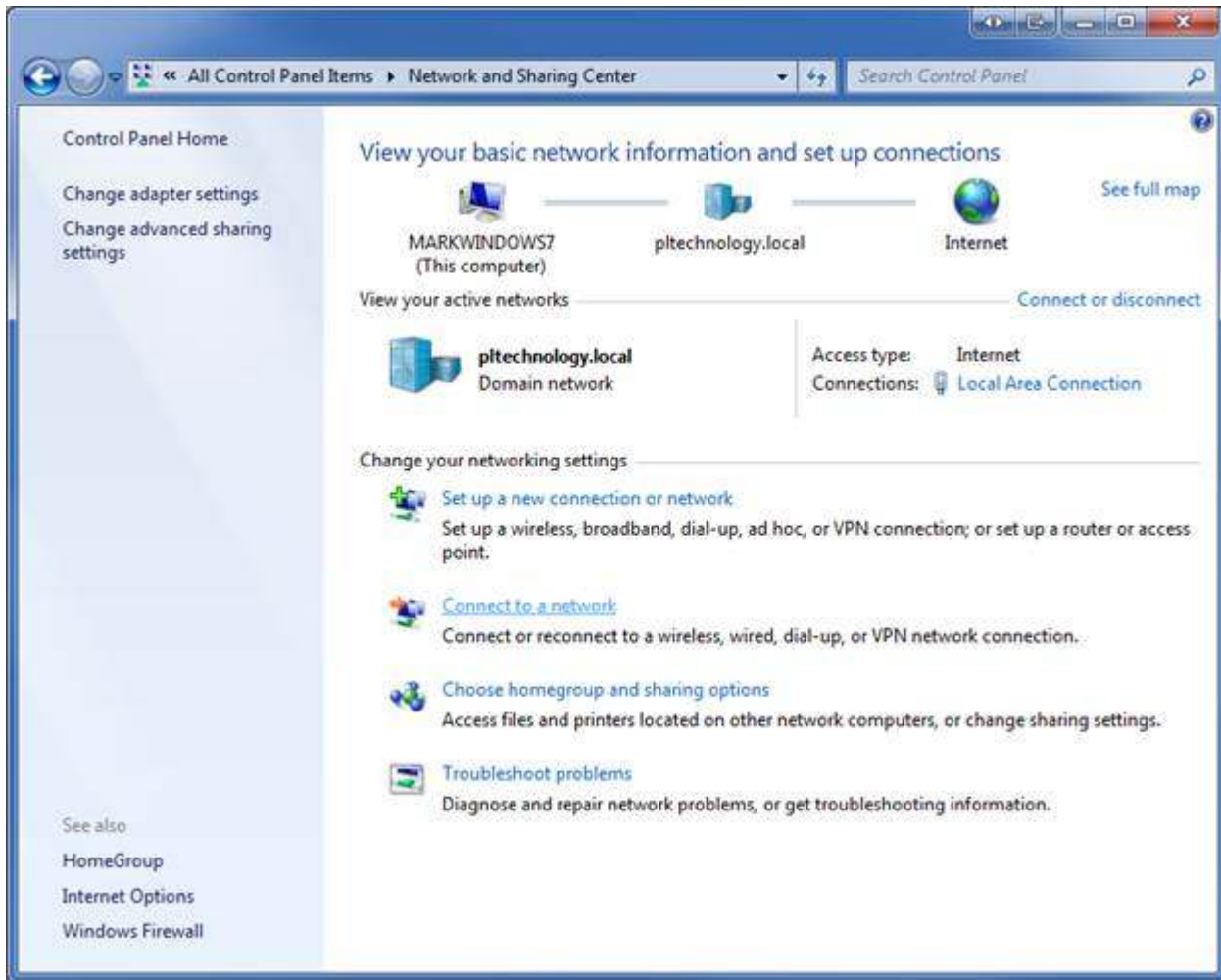




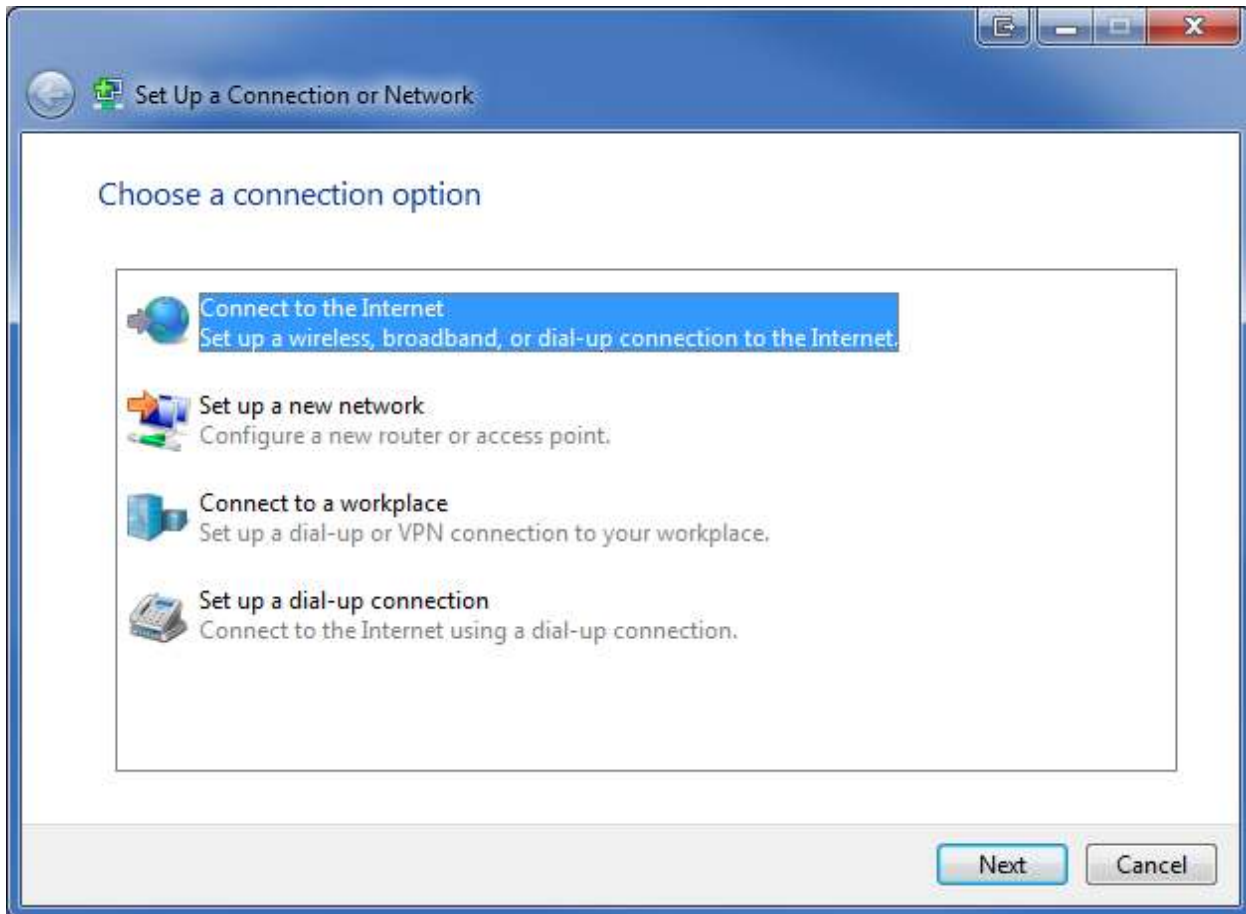
Click on “start” then “control panel”



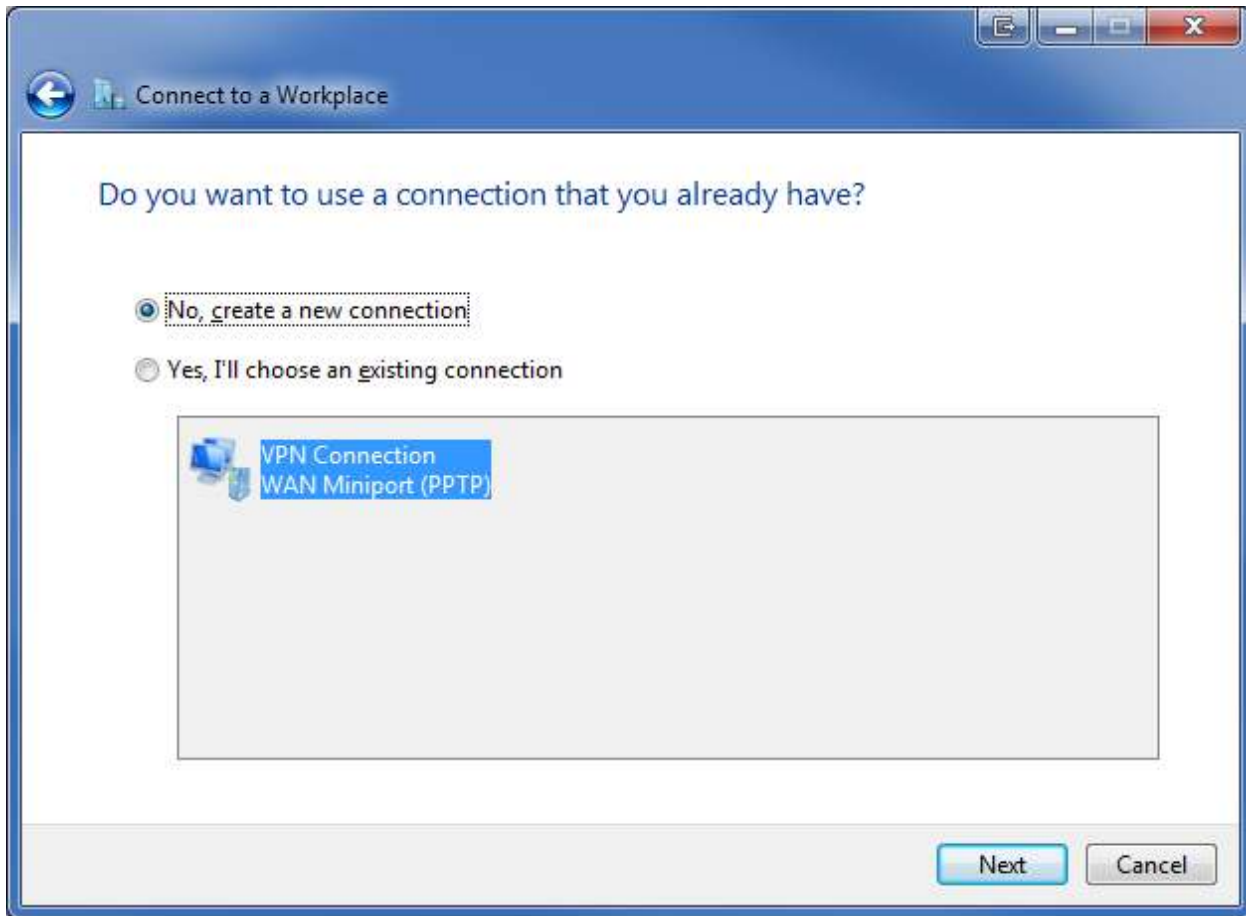
Click "network and sharing center"



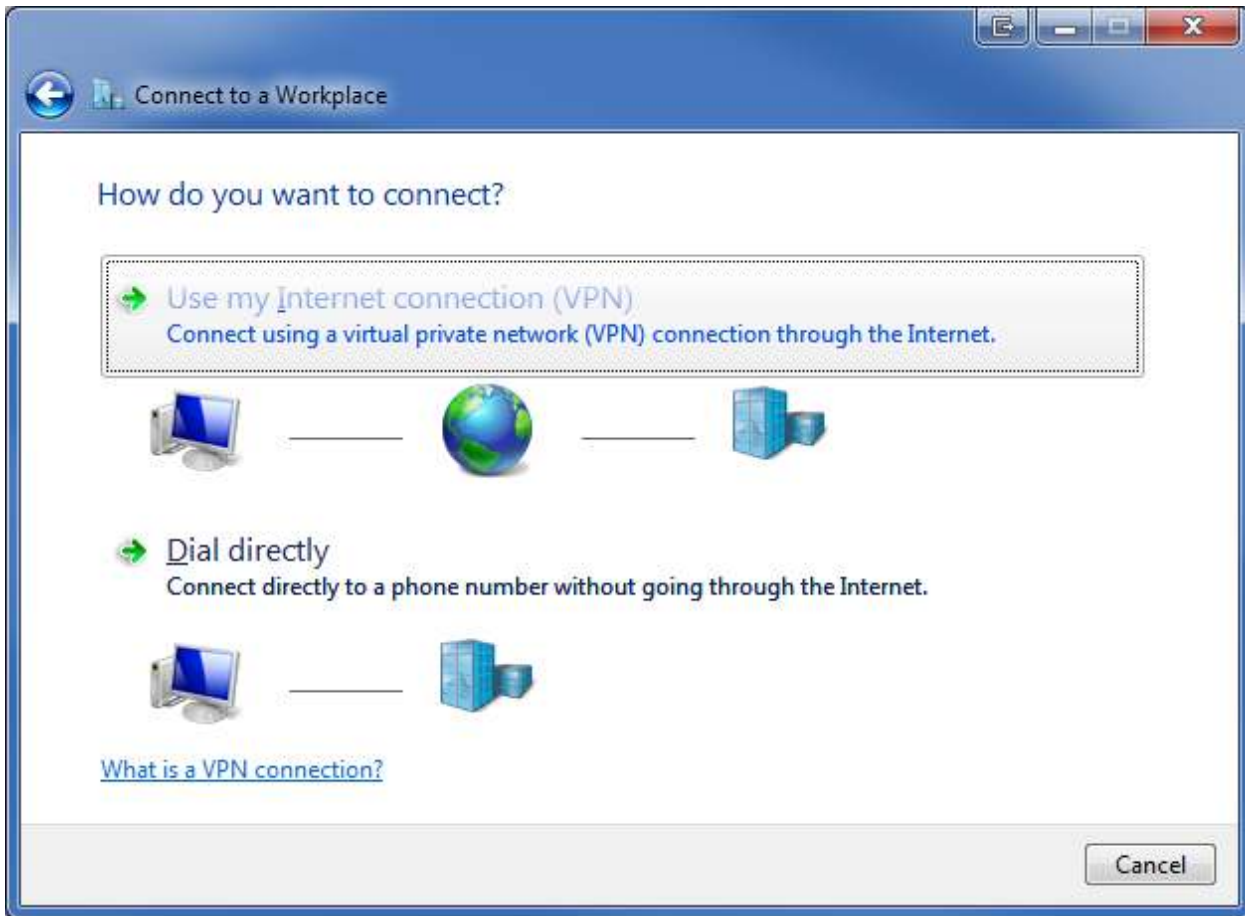
Click "Set up new connection or network"



Click "Connect to a workplace"



Click “no, create a new connection” (if you see this screen)



Click “use my internet connection (VPN)”



Connect to a Workplace

Type the Internet address to connect to

Your network administrator can give you this address.

Enter internet address for your vpn connection. Typically this is “vpn.clientdomain.com” where clientdomain.com is the second part of your email address. For example, for pltechnology.com, it would be vpn.pltechnology.com.

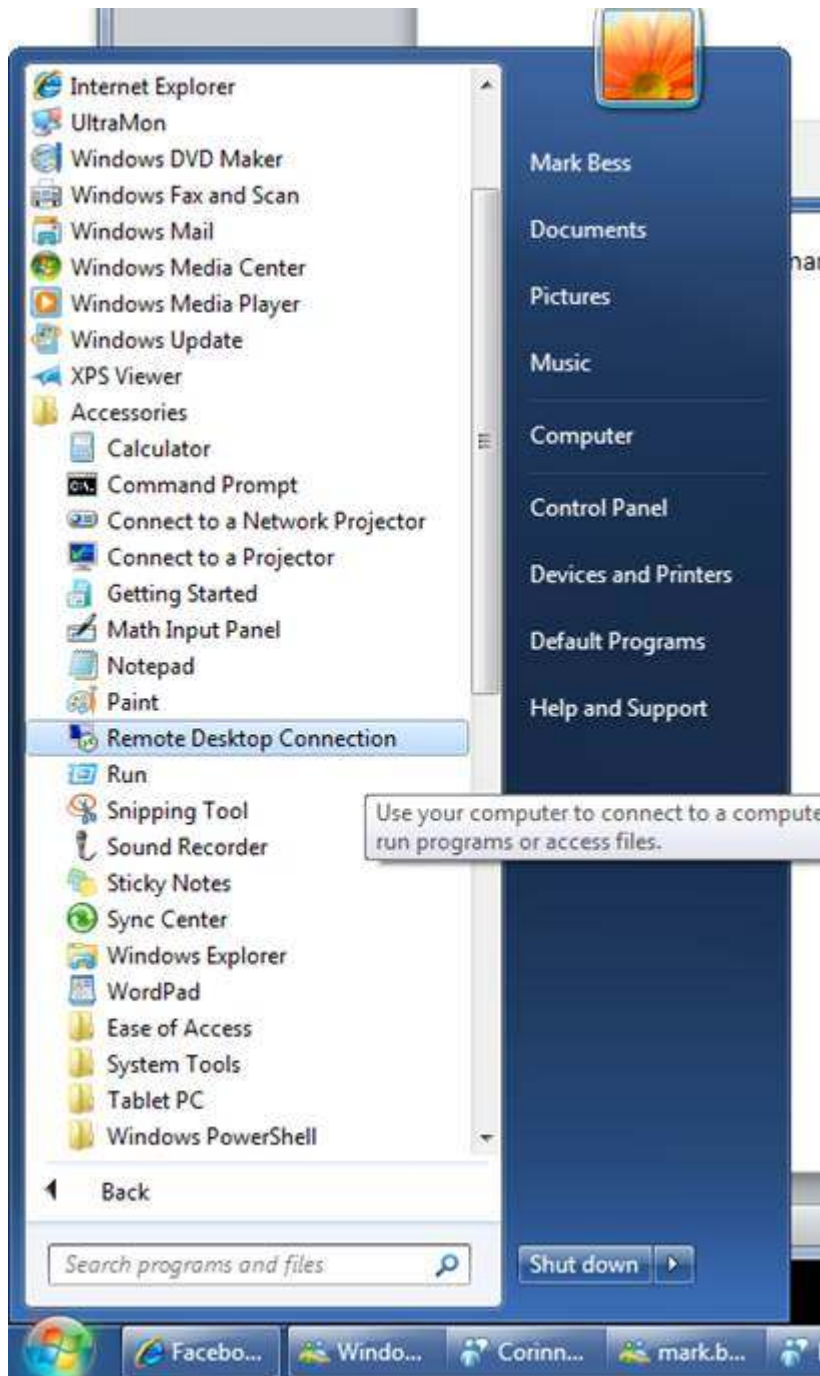
