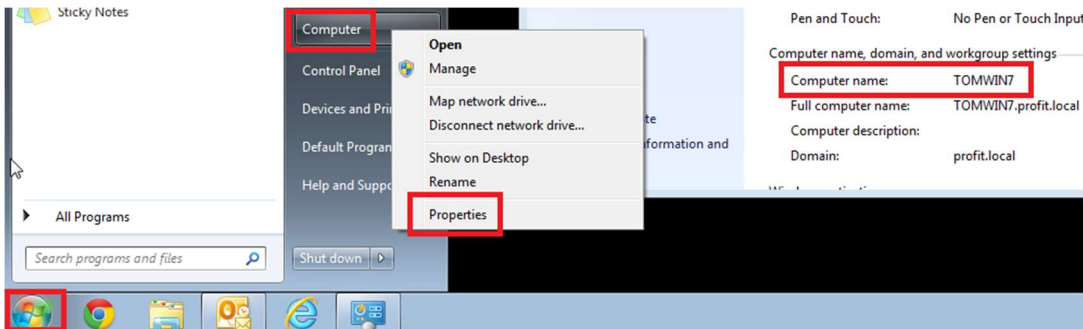




Fortinet SSL VPN Remote Access Setup

This document was created for clients that wish to connect to their work computers and will apply to clients who have deployed the Fortinet Fortigate VPN technology. If your organization uses Cisco VPN technology, please refer to that document.

Before you begin, you will need the name of your work PC. On your work PC, go to Start > right click Computer > Properties > Computer Name. In this case, we are using TOMWIN7



Step 1) Go to your VPN address in your internet browser, which is generally <https://vpn.clientdomain.com> where client domain is the last part of your email address. For example, for P&L Technology, it would be <https://vpn.pltechnology.com>.

Log in using your username and password for your work PC.

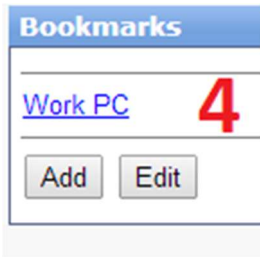

Step 4) In this case, we created a bookmark named “Work PC” using a username and password for his PC. Just click “Work PC” to connect. You will need to allow all Java prompts that may come up (see below).



You may receive these popups. Simply choose “Continue” or “Run”. If there is an option to “Don’t show this again”, choose that to speed future logins.
